## **IDEAL CANDIDATE PROFILE**

#### Responsibilities include:

- Responsible for the condition of the golf course and grounds at East Park. Roughly 100 acres in total
- Hires, trains and works closely with the grounds maintenance crew. This is a hands-on position where the superintendent works with a crew of 3-4 people. Proper employee contracts and training records to be completed as employees are hired
- Provide minor clubhouse and shop maintenance as required
- Maintenance and upkeep of all golf course equipment mostly during the winter and off months including sharpening of reels and bed knives. (we have a sharpener here)
- Responsible for all purchasing and invoice verification of all materials used for the maintenance of the property and equipment servicing such
- Review of capital equipment on a semi-annual basis
- Reports directly to General Manager
- East Park superintendent will consult with superintendents of other golf courses within our ownership group
- Participate in development, and implementation of corporate Safety and Environmental Policies. Responsible for completing MOE Water Record keeping on a daily basis and submitting it online to the MOE as required. Must complete IPM Accreditation Program and continue on with proper steps to accreditation. Must complete all requirements for full spray license
- Timely submission of all records to appropriate Ministries and copies to be given to General Manager monthly. These records referred to include but are not limited to: Water Records, Fertilizer applications, Fungicide applications
- Responsible for ongoing maintenance and repair of all equipment and power cart fleet. Consult
  on and help with equipment maintenance and repairs as required with park
  Mechanic. Cooperation with mechanic to determine priority of repairs and scheduling
- Snow Plowing using East Park's Snow Plow in Winter Season

- Maintain and upgrade industry knowledge and education.
- Working hours an average of 50 hours per week during season (March November) and an average of 32 hours during off-season (December – February). Additional hours are expected during the season as required.

- Preferably some supervisory experience
- Community College Turf Management Diploma or equivalent
- Must hold a valid Ontario Landscape Pesticide Application License and have experience in fertilizer and pesticide application to include disease diagnosis
- Ability to communicate effectively and provide supervision, training and direction to employees
- Be a leader by example and competent in all facets of golf course maintenance
- Experience in irrigation system management and repair
- Required to work variable shifts including weekends, shift work and holidays
- Knowledge of any applicable legislation or regulations including the Occupational Health and Safety Act, WHIMS, First Aid and Safety Training and IPM
- Be able to operate equipment and demonstrate maintenance activities; ability to troubleshot problems with the irrigation system and resolve
- Equipment maintenance and mechanics an asset
